## 2.Treasurer's Report (Pedro Granja)

It was reported as July 2011, there were 670 ESB members ( of which 281 were in good standing and 398 members were not). The provisional balance, as at July 2011, was 39,583.01€s outgoing and income was 40,196.72€s. There was a reduction in the Rudolf Cimdins scholarships in 2011 (4 Romania, 2 Poland, 1 Turkey). It was noted that the membership fees had not been raised for over 10 years, with no fee changes for membership levels. The ESB newsletter was launched in March 2011 for members to be informed of specific news relating to ESB and its members.
