### 3. Secretary's Report (LDS)

The term of office for the following ESB Council members has come to an end; Luigi Ambrosio (LA), Roberto Chiesa (RC), Dirk Grijpma (DG) Julio San Roman (JSR), Matteo Santin (MS). Members RC, JSR, MS stood for re-election. The voting Ballot opened May 2013, and closed 3 June 2013. Counting was performed by a Ballot Officer who is not a member of the ESB council. Votes were counted twice by two independent officers. The results were announced at the General Assembly at the ESB Conference in Madrid, September 2013.

Resolution to change Statutes & Byelaws (S&B) of the society: Several changes to the S&B have been discussed at length with council. The council proposed several changes, which were published in the members-only area of the homepage of the ESB in advance. At the GA, Michael Doser explained the proposed changes. No further changes were requested by the members. The resolution to change the Statutes and Byelaws as proposed by the council passed without a dissentient vote.

## 4. Treasurer & Membership Secretary Report

Financial Report balance as at 2012: outgoings 18,708.09€s, Incoming 23,240.72€s, balance as at August 2013: outgoings 11,515.57€s, Incomings 20,441.72€s. Provisional balance as at 2013: outgoing 43, 77.00€s, incoming 26,789.00€'s. Balance justification for increase in expenses is that Journal and advertising had not been paid 2011 and 2012. There were 10 Rudolf Cimdins Awards made (4 Turkey, 3 Poland, 2 India, 1 Slovenia)

Athena and Secal (Strasbourg, France) have been hired to provide ESB services (as the ESB was originally registered in 1976 in Strasbourg, France). Athena will provide domiciliation services and Secal will provide professional secretariat and accounting services. A New bank account has been opened in Strasbourg

The books and balances have been examined and found to be in good order; the auditors confirmed the balance and accounts to be accurate.

## 6.JMS:MiM Editor Journal of Materials Science: Materials in Medicine (JAP/MS)

Prof Josep Planell has resigned from his role as Editor, he has served the journal for many years contributing to its improvement. Prof Santin has been asked to replace him from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014.

A new section dedicated to short communication will be implemented in the New Year to provide both the authors and the readers with a flexible channel of communication of knowledge. The format of this type of communication is currently under development and it is predicted that the journal will start publishing the short communication as early as possible in 2014.
