Minutes

The General Assembly was conducted in person during the 32nd ESB Conference at Bordeaux.

- **Approval of the Agenda**

Approved unanimously.

- **Approval of the 2021 General Assembly Minutes**

Approved unanimously.

- **President Report**

The ESB President, Ana Pêgo, addressed the assembly to:

- present the current council members, as well as their duties within the council and their expected term in office;
- celebrate the contribution of Prof. Etienne Schacht to the field of Biomaterials Science, his long-standing role as an educator and mentor and as an Ambassador of ESB;
- report on the number of ESB members and the advantages of being a society member;
- report on the role of the IUSBSE, how to become an IUSBSE Fellow and the criteria & nomination process for new IUSBSE Fellows in 2023.

- **ESB Awards**

Ana Pêgo presented the ESB Scientific awards and congratulated the 2022 Awardees. It was also highlighted the George Winter Award will be sponsored by Materials Today Bio, which is an Elsevier publication. The Scientific Awards Committee for 2023 was presented. Luigi Ambrosio will step down from the Committee. Abhay Pandit will be part of the committee as the George Winter Awardee of 2022 and Peter Dubrueel will also be joining the Scientific Awards Committee for 2023. The requirements for 2023 nominations were presented for each of the ESB Scientific awards. The deadline for the nominations is November 30, 2022.

- **ESB Education Awards**

Karine Anselme reported on the following education awards:

- Julia Polak European Doctorate Awards - 10 Awardees in 2022. The awardees were announced during the YSF General Assembly held on the 6th of September 2022 during ESB 2022.
- Racquel LeGeros Award – No applications were received. Social media and ESB newsletters will be used to promote the call for nominations for the Racquel LeGeros Award in 2023. Additionally, there are now two deadlines for nominations (i.e., 31st of May and 30th of Nov).
- Rudolf Cimdins Scholarships – there were no applications in 2022. Social media and ESB newsletters will be used to promote the Rudolf Cimdins Scholarship scheme in 2023, as well as an early announcement on the ESB 2023 conference website.
- Presentation Awards during the ESB2022 conference: Four Best Student Oral Presentations and Four Best Student Poster Presentations. Winners will be notified during the Closing Ceremony of the ESB conference (8th September, 12:15 - 13:00).

- **Treasurer Report**

Silvia Farè presented the Treasurer report, detailing the expenses and revenues of 2021.

- **Auditor's Report**

E. Pamula, on behalf of the Auditors' team (E. Pamula and O. Sigurjónsson), proposed to approve the accounting for 2021. These were approved unanimously.

- **Treasurer Report (continuation)**

Silvia Farè continued with the Treasurer report to:

- present the proposed budget for 2023 and a breakdown of proposed expenses, which was unanimously approved;
- present the change in number of ESB members from 2015 to 31st of August 2022.

- **ESB Journal update**

Cristina Barrias reported on the recent developments and activities of the RSC Biomaterials Science journal. Namely:

- Impact Factor: 7,590 (2022);
- One Editorial Board member, three Associate Editors (30%), and 30% of the Advisory Board of the journal are based in Europe;
- RSC supported activities at ESB 2022;
- Dedicated Biomaterials Science scientific session took place on the 5th of Sept 2022 at ESB 2022;
- 2022 Biomaterials Science Lectureship award (Dr. Yizhou Dong, Ohio State University, USA);
- 120 invitations were issued for the ESB 2021 collection, 43 submissions were received and 19 manuscript were accepted for publication in RSC Biomaterials Science (i.e., 44% acceptance rate);
- ESB 2022 collection (50 invitations issued in July 2022 and 16 have agreed to submit a manuscript);
- Current benefits to ESB Members.

- **YSF Update**

Aldo Boccaccini reported on the activities of the Young Scientists' Forum, namely:

- Aims and objectives of YSF
- Previous and current YSF Board members;
- Overview of YSF scientific sessions and social activities at ESB 2022;
- YSF budget for 2022 and the provisional YSF budget for 2023;
- Representatives of 19 local YSF chapters and call for identification of YSF representatives in countries without a representing member;
- Overview of YSF National Chapter initiatives relating to scientific symposia, educational activities and networking events;
- Presentation of four YSF sponsored projects for 2021 and 2022;
- Call for Projects - YSF Workshop Sponsoring 2023 (Deadline January 31, 2023);
- YSF Communication and Dissemination;
- YSF Logo Design competition.

- **Affiliated Societies update**

Maria Grazia Raucci reported on the:

- Updated list of National Societies;
- Activities and discussions towards the engagement of the ESB with all the Affiliated Societies conducted during the current year (i.e., 16th of Feb 2022 and 5th of Sept 2022);
- Scientific symposium session (titled “Sustainability of Biomaterials”) on the 8th of Sept 2022 during ESB 2022.

Sandra Van Vlierberghe communicated on the:

- **Industrial partnership update**

- Implementation of a “Startup Village” during ESB 2022;
- ESB involvement in EU policy via HealthTech4EU initiative.

- **Future ESB meetings (2023-2027)**

Sandra Van Vlierberghe presented the dates and location of the next ESB meetings and World Biomaterials Congress.

- ESB2023 will take place in Davos, Switzerland between 4-8 of September;
- CESB2024-Erlangen (Germany) is currently being planned.
- WBC 2024 will take place in Daegu, Republic of Korea between 26-31 of May;
- ESB2025 will take place in Torino, Italy between 7-11 of September;
- ESB2026 will take place in Ghent, Belgium between 7-11 of September;
- ESB2027 will take place in Uppsala, Sweden (dates to be confirmed);
- Bids for the organisation of the ESB2029 will be taken until January 31st, 2024.
