Call for Nominations: ESB Education Awards & Scholarships 2025

We would like to remind you of the deadline for applications for ESB's <u>Raquel le Geros Award</u>, with a submission deadline of May 31, 2025, and the <u>Rudolf Cimdins Scholarships</u>, with a new submission deadline of June 15, 2025, please visit our Education page on the website. Note that the Rudolf Cimdins Scholarships are given by the ESB council and cover the full ESB conference registration fee of students (Bachelor, Master or PhD) who would otherwise not be able to attend the conference, as they come from a poorly funded country/group = Human Development Index (HDI) < 0.850.

The ESB Council is pleased to endorse some of the upcoming events related to the Biomaterials field including the 'AO Orthopaedic Research Summit 2025' on June 16-19, 2025 and the 'BIOMAT International Summer School 2025' on July 7-11, 2025. The AO Orthopaedic Research Summit 2025 is a particularly special event as three societies combine minds to advance science and clinical impact: ARI Orthopaedics, the European Orthopaedic Research Society (EORS), and the International Society for Computer-Assisted Orthopaedic Surgery (CAOS). The BIOMAT International Summer School 2025 will provide participants, including postdoctoral researchers, PhD and Master's students, as well as early-career academics, with the opportunity to attend scientific lectures by leading international experts, participate in hands-on workshops, and enhance their essential soft skills. Call for Nominations: ESB Council Membership

We invite you to nominate candidates for one of the five seats that will become available on our council in September 2025. Eligible candidates must be ESB members in good standing. Candidates need to be nominated by another ESB member who is also in good standing. Nominations should include a one-page resume and a nominee application letter, both signed by the nominee. Nominations should be sent by the nominators to secretary@esbiomaterials.eu. The nomination deadline is March 14, 2025 (13:00 CET), and the online voting system will be from March 15-31, 2025.

Annual Membership

As March approaches, a **reminder to all ESB members that membership fees are due by March 31, 2025**. Since 2018, registering for the annual ESB conference has automatically granted ESB membership for the upcoming period, effective from the registration date, as per ESB bylaws. In years with a World Biomaterials Congress instead of an ESB conference, membership is extended for two years without annual renewal, ensuring continuous benefits for attendees.
