3. ESB education awards

The deadline for the application to the ESB education awards is approaching! The European Society for Biomaterials sponsors two education awards dedicated to young scientists. The deadline for the <u>Julia Polak European</u> <u>Doctorate Award</u> and the <u>Racquel LeGeros Award</u> is January 31st.

Julia Polak European Doctorate Award. The award is a scientific recognition for the obtainment of the PhD degree. The award is given by the ESB council and presented during the Annual conference of the Society; the winners will receive a certificate of merit. Requirements and the application form can be found on the ESB website.

• **Racquel LeGeros Award**. This award is given to two graduate students per year who would like to pursue their research in International or European academic laboratories or companies dedicated to biomaterials and regenerative medicine. The aim is to increase the knowledge in a specific topic and /or a technology. The application should be sent to secretary@esbiomaterials.eu, by following the instructions provided on the <u>ESB website</u>.
